

Syllabus for the BRCC Written Examination

The written examination will test "**the level of knowledge & aptitude**" as may be expected of a learned, well qualified, competent & well-informed dedicated teacher. The examination will include questions on the following:

1. General Issues related to School Education.
2. Government Initiatives and programmes for enhancement of quality education.
3. General knowledge.
4. Knowledge of basic concepts of matriculation standard as may be expected of a well-qualified person.
5. General mental ability,
6. Writing skills in English, as well as Hindi.

Note:

1 Examination will consist of two Sections A & B. Section A will consist of 40 MCQs, and Section B will consist of two long answer type questions to test the writing skills of candidates in English and Hindi (not more than 300 words each).

2 There will be negative marking for wrong answers in Section A. However, if a question is left unattempted, no marks will be deducted.
